Friday, July 28th, 7:00pm: *A Conversation with Rita Braver*

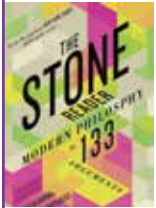

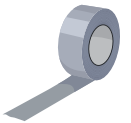
